## EAA 154 Meeting May 3<sup>rd</sup> Disley CDS2

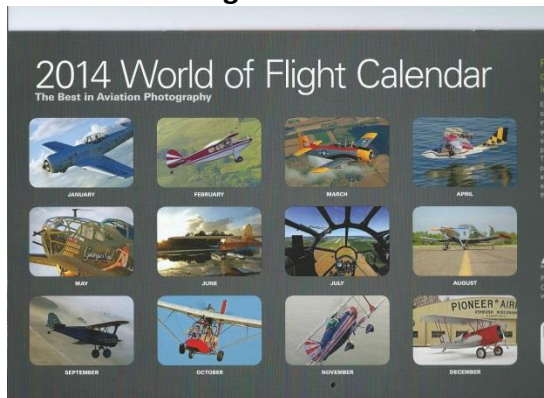
The coffee pot will be on at the Disley airstrip 9:00 to 12:00 Saturday May 3<sup>rd</sup>.
